

## ALCOHOL POLICY FOR ALL DSOL PRESENTATION BALL EVENTS HELD AT THE MEYERSON

1. ID checks will be handled solely by Culinaire staff as they are the holders of the TABC liquor license and are responsible for its enforcement.
2. Attendees wishing to drink must present a valid driver's license
3. All drivers' licenses will be scanned.
4. Passports will not be accepted.
5. Anyone wishing to consume alcohol at an event held at the Morton H. Meyerson Symphony Center whose age might be in question must wear a wristband on their right wrist. "No wristband; no alcohol."
6. Wristbands will be purchased and supplied only by Culinaire staff.
7. Wristbands will be attached by the Culinaire staff after they have verified the person's age.
8. ID verification and a wristband will be required for anyone 35 years of age or younger. Anyone who feels their age might be questioned should stop by the check-in table, present their ID, and have a wristband secured to their right wrist.
9. Bartenders retain the right to question the age of *anyone* requesting a drink whose age is, to them, in question and can refuse service to anyone whose age they question. It will be helpful to remind everyone that when this occurs, the bartenders are just doing their job, and their authority to do so should be respected. Dallas police and security personnel will be present at all events and will intercede when asked if a bartender's authority is being questioned or a guest's behavior is inappropriate.
10. Torn or partial wristbands will not be honored. Those with damaged or questionable wristbands should return to the ID check table to get a new wristband. **To get a torn or removed wristband reissued, both the torn/removed wristband and a valid ID must be presented at the ID check table.**
11. Flasks: Everyone attending the Ball is reminded that bringing alcohol into the Meyerson, which is a City building, is illegal. Anyone seen with a flask will have it confiscated, emptied, and returned to them. To avoid potentially embarrassing situations, flasks should be left at home.
12. Bartenders will give a maximum of two drinks to any one person standing in line.
13. Bars will be closed at the discretion of Culinaire, the Meyerson and/or the Dallas Symphony Association.
